



THE UNIVERSITY OF LILLE

The University of Lille is a European university recognized for the excellence of its long-life learning. For 2020's school start, the University set up a revamped training offer in its diplomas, programs and educational modalities which puts students at the very heart of its concerns, to enable students involvement and success.

The University offers 195 formations in line with the socioeconomic world's development, supported with cutting-edge research at a global level led by 62 research units in order to respond to today's complex challenges.

THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES

The Faculty of Humanities train close to 7000 students in diverse fields of study such as archeology, arts, history and history of art, modern literature, classics, philosophy and language science.

The Faculty is comprised of seven formation departments, five research labs and several libraries.

Within the Faculty, the **Philosophy Department** offers to students complete philosophical training courses :

- Bachelor's degree :
 - Philosophy,
 - Philosophy-sociology,
- Master's degree :
 - Arts, Ethic Policy and Society,
 - Contemporary Philosophy,
 - Philosophy, Knowledge, Rationalities.

The department also train for the aggregation of philosophy and takes part in courses of the master « Métiers de l'enseignement, de l'Education et de la Formation » (Teaching, Education and Formation Professions) in collaboration with the INSPE (National Higher Institute of Teaching and Education).

The Department of Philosophy is composed of a teaching team of 16 incumbent teachers/researchers along with several part time or contracted teachers, as well as a two persons administrative and technical team.

Training courses in the Department are supported by the UMR STL (Knowledge, Texts, Language research lab), in which most of the teachers/researchers in philosophy develop their research activities.

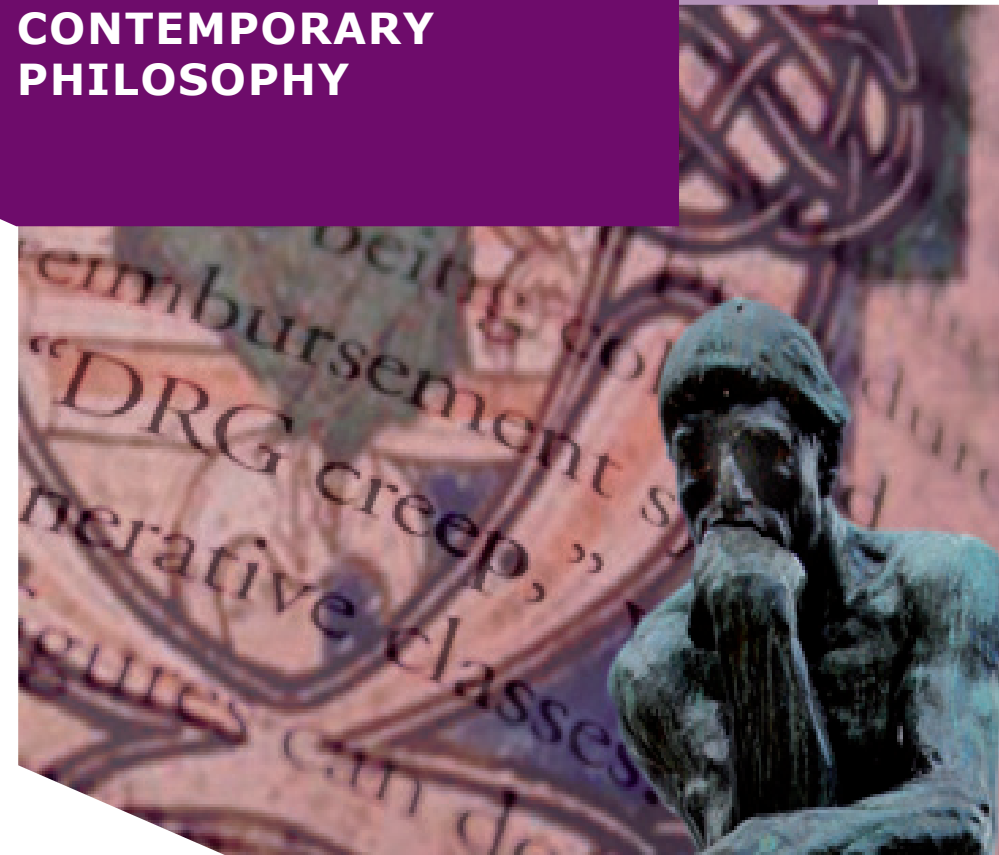

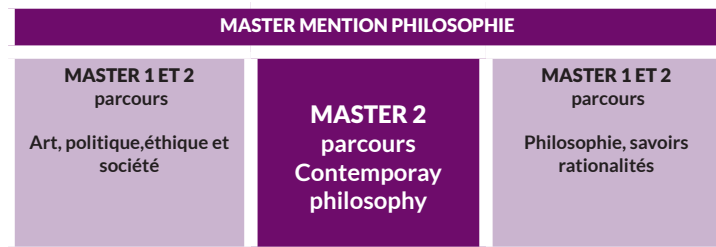

OBJECTIVES

Do you have a research project in contemporary philosophy ? Do you want to use english as a working language ? The **Contemporay Philosophy Master** offers an international course with contemporary philosophy debates at the UMR STL (Knowledge, Texts, Language research lab) and at the philosophy department.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

IN SECOND YEAR (M2)

Anglophone, europeans and international students in possession of a + 4 years post-secondary education (including 2 years in philosophy).

You have different degrees, a personal or professional experience in connection with philosophy.

You can apply in Master 2 Contemporay Philosophy.

PRESENTATION

- First year (M1) core course introducing the areas, subjects and reserch methods in philosophy, with a pre-specialization which includes an introduction research course in either of the following fields : Arts, Ethic Policy and Society, or, Philosophy, Knowledge, Rationalities.

- 3 curriculum in M2 : Arts, Ethic Policy and Society (art philosophy, moral, political and social philosophy) ; Philosophy, Knowledge, Rationalities (philosophy history, general philosophy, language and knowledge philosophy, metaphysics, logic and sciences philosophy ; Contemporary philosophy (english courses about the main contemporary philosophy's problems, areas and trends).

- A research paper per year and a progress report every mid school year.

ORGANIZATION

The Master contains two elements :

- Active involvement in required classes and seminars chosen by the student.
- Research paper writing (M1 : minimum 50 pages, M2 : minimum 75 pages), under the supervision of a

teacher/researcher from the philosophy department. Students need to present their paper in front of a two persons jury. This paper involves an important personal investment as well as frequent exchanges with the paper supervisor.
